

## *Crocheted Skull Cap*

H hook if you crochet loosely

4-Ply Black, Dark Green, Navy Blue, or Brown yarn (**dark colors ONLY**)

Chain 4, close for a ring, Chain 3 (all Ch 3 count as DC)

Round 1: 11 DC in ring, close ring with sl st in top of Ch 3; (12 sts) Ch 3

Round 2: 2 DC in each st around; sl st in top of Ch 3 (24 st) Ch 3

Round 3: \*2 DC in first st, 1 DC in next st (repeat from \* around) Ch 3 (36 sts)

Round 4: Repeat round 3 (54 sts)

Round 5: \*2 DC in first st; 1 DC in each of next 6 sts; (repeat from \* around DC in last 4 sts) Ch 3 (62 sts) Ch 3

Round 6 to 11: DC in each st; close each round as before (62 sts)

Round 12: DC around front post in first st; around back post in second st (the st of the previous row are now your "posts." Yarn over hook, go down on one side of the post and up the other and continue the DC. On the next st come up from back of post and go down the other side, finish DC) [Repeat around to form ribbing] (all rows 62 sts each) fasten off, weave in the end.

## *Knitted Skull Cap*

Size 10 needle

4-Ply Black, Dark Green, Navy Blue, or Brown yarn (**dark colors ONLY**)

Cast on 76 stitches loosely

K2 P2 until piece measures 6 inches

Next row-K2 together across

Next row-Knit across

Next row-K2 together

Continue in the manner until 5 sts remain

Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull tight, and sew back seam.
