



# Amur Maple

*Acer ginnala*



**Height:** 15' to 20'

**Width:** 15' to 20'

**Minimum Terrace  
Width Required:** 72"

**Hardiness Zone:** 3 to 7

**Crown:** Rounded to irregular shape

**Foliage:** Dark green, simple leaves are 3 lobed, with a long pointed central lobe. The entire leaf may be 1½ - 3" in length. Fall color is vivid scarlet red.

**Flowers:** Fragrant, not particularly noticeable

**Fruit:** Double samaras, turns from green to red to brown in mid-summer and can be quite abundant.

**Bark:** Light gray and smooth in youth, changing to slight vertical furrowing and subtle striped look in middle age.

**Description:** A small tree which may be used in a wide terrace. It grows almost as wide as it does tall.

**Limitations:** Abundant seed can be a litter problem. It is susceptible to 2, 4-D drift.

**Site and Culture:** Transplants readily. Will tolerate shade, but develops better fall color in full sun.
