Foliage:	Summer leaves are a rich medium green , fall color is a presistent bbright orange.		
Flowers:	Reddish, in clusters on female.		
Fruit:	Nearly seedless		
Description:	The Freeman Maple is a cross with a Red and Silver Maple that was introduced in the late 1960..		
Advantages:	Salt resistant and has very few pest problems. Most cultivars have a good branching habit which make it more storm resistant then it Silver Maple parent. Ha a vigorous growth rate and will reach full size in 30 years.		
Limitations:	Gray, thin bark is easily damaged when tree is young.		
Site and Culture:	Prefers rich, well drained soil, tolerates urban pollution and dry conditions better than parents, tolerates most soils.		
Recommended Cultivars:	Autumn Blaze, Celebration, Jeffersred
