

2019/2020 Adult Fall/Winter Volleyball Leagues

GENERAL INFO: Matches are played at school gymnasiums. Game balls are provided by the department. A gym supervisor will be at the gymnasium each night. Scores must be turned in to the gym supervisor at the end of the match.

LEAGUE PLAY: Players are limited to **ONE LEAGUE** per night. Teams using ineligible players will forfeit their game. Players are reminded to play at **THEIR** skill level.

EXCEPTION: *Coed Power "A" Quads may also play on a Coed "A" League.*

ROSTERS: The Watertown Park & Recreation Department leagues ARE NOT OPEN ROSTER LEAGUES! Each team captain must submit a team roster that includes all eligible players (including subs).

FORFEITURES:

- (a) Failure to field 4 players, five minutes after the scheduled game time results in forfeiture of the first game. Failure to field 4 players by fifteen minutes after the scheduled game time results in forfeiture of all 3 games.
- (b) If a team begins its match with 4 or 5 players and additional players arrive after play begins, they may rotate in the center back position at the time of the team's next rotation.
- (c) A team that allows ineligible players or players who have played in a different league on the same night will forfeit all 3 games.

SUBSTITUTIONS: A team that is unable to field enough players may openly substitute off-roster with the full understanding that the result is forfeiture of all 3 games.

GYM SUPERVISOR: The department has an on-site supervisor in place to oversee the operations of the league. They are not on site to referee, settle disputes, pass judgment, clarify rules, etc.

CONDUCT: All players and spectators are asked to conduct themselves in such a manner so as to promote a fun, social, family type atmosphere. No smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages, no profane or vulgar language is permitted.

NO CHILDREN: Please DO NOT BRING CHILDREN to your game. There are no areas at any gym for kids to play or "hang out" during games. This is a requirement that we need to honor to continue our shared use relationship with the school district.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: When school is closed for weather or other issues, our programs are also closed down—the department will inform team captains of the game status via Facebook, text and email.

REQUESTS: The department will do their best to honor game-time requests. However, in some cases, it just might not be possible.
