The Watertown Park and Recreation Department is offering a yearly pass for the Indoor Pool at Riverside Middle School located at 131 Hall Street. A family pass may consist of 5 “immediate” family members living in the same household. There is a \$15 charge for each additional family member. Please note that proof of residency may be requested. Taxes are included in the fees.

The pass is valid from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021

Watertown Indoor Pool Policies During COVID-19

1. All swimming is by reservation only. No drop in visits permitted. Reservations must be made at <https://watertownwi.recdesk.com> and paid for in advance by purchasing a Season Pass or paying the Daily Admission Fee at the time the reservation is made. Payment may not be made at the Indoor Pool.
2. If a reservation needs to be cancelled, participants must call the Park and Recreation Department Office at 920.262.8080 during office hours (Monday through Friday, 8am – 4:30pm) to cancel the reservation in advance. Kindly give at least 24 hours' notice, so others may have the opportunity to make a reservation.
3. Spaces must be reserved in the name of the person who will be attending, due to potential contact tracing issues. Reservations may not be made on behalf of other people. Lanes/spaces may not be shared- there is a limit of one person per lane/zone.
4. Participants must complete a symptom screening and temperature check upon arrival at the pool.
5. Pool admission refused to all persons exhibiting symptoms of an illness, open wound, or infectious condition.
6. It is the policy of the Watertown Unified School District and the Watertown Park and Recreation Department that all participants wear a face mask inside the facility unless they are in the pool water. Entry will be denied to those not wearing a face mask.
7. Social distancing/at least 6 feet of separation is required at all times.
8. Locker room facilities are closed/changing areas are not available. Please plan to wear your swimsuit to and from the pool and bring appropriate clothing for weather. Changing clothes on the pool deck or in bathroom facilities is not permitted.
9. Facility doors will not be unlocked early/prior to reservation start times due to sanitation procedures. No early arrivals or staying past reservation ending times. Participants must exit the facility promptly at their reservation ending time so sanitation procedures can take place. Please plan your swim time and drying off/dressing time to fit within this timeframe accordingly.
10. Pool equipment will not be available – please bring your own kickboards, fins, jogging belts, etc. if you plan to use them.
11. Deep water zones are for treading and jogging – they are not areas for swimming.
12. Never enter the water until lifeguard is on duty.
13. Walk at all times on the pool deck and throughout the facility.
14. Refrain from shoving, dunking and dangerous activity in the water or on deck.
15. Appropriate bathing suits must be worn -- no cut-offs, jean shorts, street clothes, or thongs.
16. No food, drink, gum, smoking materials or glass allowed in the pool or locker rooms.
17. Season pass may only be used by the person listed on the season pass card.
18. Children ages 8 and under must be accompanied by an adult, who is within an arm's reach of the child in the water and at all times.
19. Follow the directions of the aquatics staff at all times.
20. Failure to follow these or other policies may result in suspension or revocation of participant's Season Pass and use of the pool.

**Watertown Indoor Pool Policies
Post-COVID-19**

1. All swimmers must take a shower before entering the pool.
2. Never enter the water until lifeguard is on duty.
3. Walk at all times on the deck and throughout the facility.
4. Refrain from shoving, dunking and dangerous activity in the water or on deck.
5. Appropriate bathing suits must be worn -- no cut-offs, jean shorts, street clothes, or thongs.
6. Children ages 8 and under must be accompanied by an adult, who is within an arm's reach of the child in the water and at all times.
7. No food, drink, gum, smoking materials or glass allowed in the pool, locker rooms or spectator seating.
8. Pool admission refused to all persons exhibiting symptoms of an illness, open wound, or infectious condition
9. Swimming equipment is the property of the aquatics department and is available for instructional and lap swim only. Personal equipment may be used at the discretion of the lifeguard.
10. Season pass may only be used by the person listed on the season pass card.
11. No street shoes on the pool deck.
12. Follow the directions of the aquatics staff at all times.
13. Failure to follow these or any other policies may result in Season Pass being revoked.
